

WINTERIZE YOUR EQUIPMENT

How to protect your pressure washer from freezing!

Cold Water Unit

Method #1 – Requires RV or Regular Anti-Freeze

1. Run the chemical line into a gallon of anti-freeze
2. Turn on machine and insert the black nozzle into the quick connect coupler to activate the chemical pick up.
3. Run machine until you see the anti-freeze coming out of the nozzle.
4. Run machine for 10-12 seconds to ensure that everything is internally coated with anti-freeze

****This must be done between each use during the winter****

Method #2

1. Turn off water supply and disconnect all hoses.
2. Turn on machine for 10-15 seconds or until all water is out of the system.
3. Drain the high-pressure hose by holding the trigger gun vertically to the ground and squeezing the trigger.
4. Store machine in a warm dry building.

****This must be done between each use during the winter****
